Developments in the Hydrocarbon E&P Sector

Both countries have undergone fiscal and structural reforms and wish to attract U.S. companies to participate in hydrocarbon exploration and production. Cyprus has granted six concessions and Greece recently granted three concessions to companies to explore oil and gas deposits.

The Greek government plans to publish in the coming weeks an international tender for offshore hydrocarbon exploration concessions in the Ionian Sea and south of Crete, following the recent seismic survey completion by PGS. The Republic of Cyprus government is interested in monetizing its offshore natural gas deposits, exploring various options for exporting its own natural gas, and transforming Cyprus into a regional energy hub.

Both Governments are encouraging joint ventures between local and Western companies. Learn more about gas and oil exploration and production framework and how your company can better position itself for the opportunities that lie ahead.
